COURSE IN HOSPITAL :

35 Years old male admitted on 02.11.12 early morning with history of severe abdominal pain. Patient has history of abdomen pain since 30.10.12 evening around 4.30 pm and worsening of pain since 1.11.12 evening more in epigastrium. Patient consulted as outpatient on 1.11.12 late evening, as pain persisted patient reported to ER after few hours. No history of vomiting, haematemesis, melena. No history of fever, bodyache. History of high coloured urine x 2 days. No history of chest pain, breathlessness, cough.

PMH : Not a Diabetic, Hypertensive.

On arrival patient conscious, oriented, afebrile, PERL, BP – 130/90mmHg, PR – 98/min, CVS – S1S2+, Lungs – BAE, Abdomen – soft, BS+, Epigastric tenderness +, CNS - NFNND.

Patient started on IV Pantoprazole 40mg BD, IV Droitin 80mg bd.
Preliminary labs s/o platelets 193K, TLC 10200, Creatinine – 2.0, Serum amylase – 57, Serum lipase – 211.0, CRP – Positive, ESR elevated.

USG whole abdomen showed mild splenomegaly (31.10.12)
Urine albumin ++++, Blood +++.
