ULTRASOUND WHOLE ABDOMEN (BEDSIDE, SCREENING)

The liver is normal in size and shows uniform echotexture with no focal abnormality.
 The gall bladder is normal sized and smooth walled and contains no calculus.
 There is no intra or extra hepatic biliary ductal dilatation.
 The pancreas shows a normal configuration and echotexture. The pancreatic duct is normal.
 The portal vein and the IVC are normal.
 The spleen is mildly enlarged (13.7 cms). No focal lesion is seen.
 There is no free or loculated peritoneal fluid.
 No para aortic lymphadenopathy is seen.
 No abnormality is seen in the region of the adrenal glands.
 The right kidney measures 9.8 x 4.4 cms. It is normal in size and shows normal cortical echoes. There is no calculus or calyceal dilatation.
 The right ureter is not dilated.
